Cubpack 170 generally meets on the 3rd Tuesday of each school month.

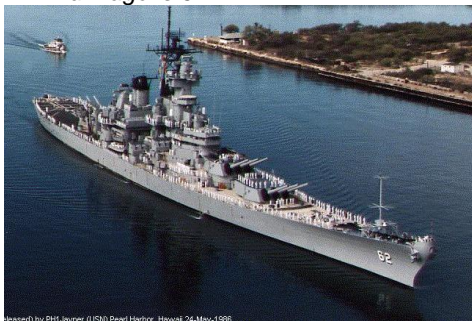
Interested in helping? Have ideas or suggestions? Committee meetings are held at The Sly Fox on the 1st Wednesday of the month.
